

Get out the vote in **Wisconsin**

Election Day: November 3

Why should you vote?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2016, 43% of the eligible voting-age population (nearly 100 million Americans) did *not* cast a vote for president; and 38.6% did *not* vote for any office.

In 2016, the Black voter turnout rate declined for the first time in 20 years in a presidential election, falling from a record-high 66.6% in 2012 to 59.6% in 2016.

Wisconsin's absentee and mail-in voting procedures

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- No excuse required to request an absentee ballot

2020 state absentee / mail-in voting status:

- Coronavirus updates: Online voter registration and absentee ballot request deadlines extended for the April 7, 2020, election; no announced changes for the November 3, 2020 general election.

Deadlines to know for voting in Wisconsin

Voter registration deadline:

October 14, 2020

Twenty days before an election

Same-day registration is also permitted on Election Day

Early in-person voting deadlines:

Early in-person voting **14 days before the election.**

In-person absentee voting **ends 2 days before the election.**

Varies by municipality. Voters should contact their county elections office for additional information.

Absentee / Mail-In voting ballot deadlines:

Request must be received by

October 29, 2020

Five days before the election

Ballot submission deadline:

Received by 8:00 pm on November 3, 2020 (Election Day).

Voter ID Requirements

ID with name & photo:

- WI driver's license *
 - WI state ID card*
 - US military ID *
 - US Passport *
 - Veteran's Affairs Card (unexpired or no expiration date)
 - WI tribal ID card (Can be current or expired)
 - WI-Accredited College ID and signature (Expires within 2 years of issuance date. If expired, also show proof of enrollment)
- *OK if expired after Nov. 6, 2018**
